Support Worker Roadshow

The package also gives you access to the Support Worker Roadshow, which is two x 1 day workshops aimed at getting Support Workers up to speed with the essential elements of Self-Directed Support and Person Centred Practice. This program is ideal for Support Workers who are champions and potential influencers across your organisation. The workshops will run throughout metro and regional Western Australia.

Workshop 1 - The fundamentals of self- direction and person centred practice

- Person centred values and approaches
- Supported Decision Making

Workshop 2 – People's lives and people's outcomes

- Understanding Outcomes and why they matter
- Supporting people to lead full lives, not just delivering support
- Critical Thinking Skills
