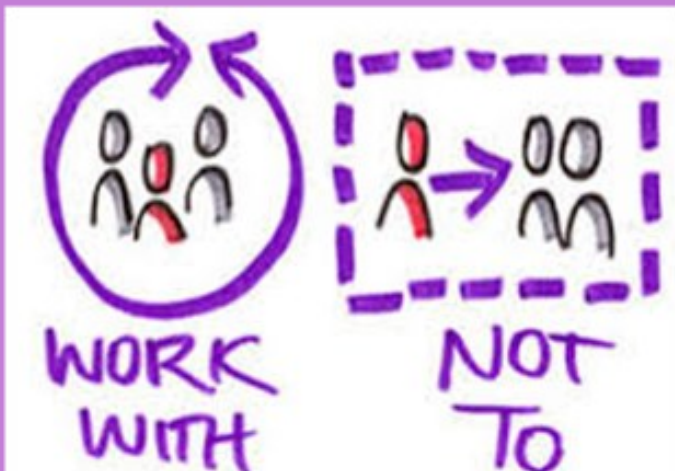
This workshop draws on international examples of co-production or genuine partnerships to design and develop services and supports to people who are looking for support now or in the future.
