
WORKSHOP 1 PREPARING TO PLAN 9AM —12PM

A former high school teacher, for many years Jaquie was one of the many parents around the country who are unable to work due to the support needs of their children with challenging behaviours. Her search for a good life for her son has lead to her exploring a number of other roles including Chair of the Positive Behaviour Framework Guiding Committee (hosted by the Disability Services Commission) and in 2013 was developer of 'Is There a Better Way' training, which has been has been delivered around the state and was designed to help other families experiencing challenging behaviour.
